Quickstart Guide:

BIM485 Research in Computer Science I & BIM486 Research in Computer Science II

- BIM485 and BIM486 are research-oriented technical elective courses. The students enrolled in these courses carry out a research project under the supervision of the instructor of the course.
- A student must be 7th semester or above, and have at least 2.50 GPA to be able to register to BIM485/BIM486.
- A student may enroll in one or both of these courses.
- The research topics of these courses cannot be the same with those of BIM437/BIM444.
- Those students who want to register these courses must get permission from the instructor from whom
 they want to take the course.
- Grading Policy: Homework (15%) + Project (20%) + Final Exam (65%)
- Grading Scale: 100-85 (AA); 84-80 (AB); 79-75 (BA); 74-70 (BB); 69-65 (BC); 64-60 (CB); 59-55 (CC); 54-50 (CD); 49-45 (DC); 44-40 (DD); 39-0 (FF).
